

EXPO NEWS FROM HUNGARY

The SIRHA Budapest of this year has concluded

Enormous success – this is the best summary of this SIRHA Budapest. The most significant international food industry and HoReCa trade show in Central and Eastern Europe hosted Hungary's HUNGEXPO and the region's most important gastronomy players for the sixth time this year. On 30,000 square meters, nearly 26,000 professional visitors met with over 300 exhibitors from 16 countries, which is nearly 10 percent more than two years ago. Based on the initial evaluations following the closure, participants termed the event 'surprisingly successful,' despite challenging market conditions such as rising raw material and energy prices. SIRHA Budapest once again provided space for numerous professional conferences, roundtable discussions, and professional competitions.
